

Preliminary summary of 2011/2012 federal donations

Federal Labor declared receiving \$7.5 million in donations. The federal Coalition declared \$4.7 million.

Donations to both major parties are down approximately \$4 million on last year, which is to be expected outside an election year.

At first glance:

- Property companies gave around \$700K to the Federal Labor and Liberal party divisions.
- Clubs and alcohol and gaming companies gave over \$500K to the major parties, favouring the Liberal party with \$373K.
- Resource and energy companies were generous to both parties, favouring Labor with \$462K.
- The Pharmaceutical and medical industries are still large donors with over \$500K going to the major parties.
- Manildra, historically a huge donor, continues to support both parties.
- Tobacco donations to the Coalition all but dried up last year.
